Verses from the Wise Qur'an 36, Āyah 1-8



In the Name of Allah,
The Most Merciful, the Most Compassionate.

بِسْمِ اللَّهِ الرَّحْمَنِ الرَّحِيمِ

36:1

بِسْ

Yā Sīn.

36:3

إِنَّكَ لَمِنَ الْمَرْسَلِينَ

Indeed, you are truly among the messengers.

36:5

تَنْزِيلُ الْعَزِيزِ الرَّحِيمِ

A revelation sent down from the Almighty, the
Most Merciful.

36:7

لَقَدْ حَقَّ الْقَوْلُ عَلَى أَكْثَرِهِمْ فَهُمْ لَا يُؤْمِنُونَ

The decree has certainly come true against most
of them, so they do not believe.

36:2

وَالْقُرْآنُ الْحَكِيمُ

By the Wise Qur'an.

36:4

عَلَى صِرَاطٍ مُّسْتَقِيمٍ

On a straight path.

36:6

لِتُنذِرَ قَوْمًا مَا أَنذَرَ آبَاؤُهُمْ فَهُمْ غَافِلُونَ

So that you may warn a people whose forefathers
were not warned, and so they are unaware.

36:8

إِنَّا جَعَلْنَا فِي أَعْنَاقِهِمْ أَغْلَالًا فَهِيَ إِلَى الْأَذْقَانِ فَهُمْ مُّقْمَحُونَ

Indeed, We have placed shackles around their
necks, reaching up to their chins, so their heads
are forced upward.
